Blacktown Station Upgrade

OUT OF HOURS WORK

SEPTEMBER 2017

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure. The Blacktown Station Upgrade includes:

- a new pedestrian footbridge connecting the Richmond Line concourse with the main concourse
- a new lift and stairs connecting platform 3 with the new footbridge
- new stairs and weather protection canopies to platforms 1 and 2.

Upcoming works

Further to our previous notification, additional weekend and night works will be carried out in the month of September. Work will be carried out on the following dates:

- **Monday 11 September to Friday 29 September 2017**, over four nights each week, between **6pm to 7am**
- **6am to 6pm Saturday 16 September 2017**
- **6am Sunday 17 September to 3am Monday 18 September 2017.**

Work activities will include:

- installation of structural steel on the new concourse
- roofing works on the new concourse and platforms 1,2 and 3.

What equipment will be used?

The following equipment will be used during construction:

- power and hand tools
- grinders
- welding equipment
- elevated work platform
- forklift
- mobile lighting tower

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to commuters, nearby residents and businesses.

Where required, traffic controllers will be on site to facilitate safe pedestrian and vehicle movements.
