

Transport Access Program Banksia Station Upgrade Planning approval

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Banksia Station

Planning approval has been granted for the Banksia Station Upgrade. The approval follows the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors from 11 - 25 August 2020, and preparation of a Determination Report.



Project overview

Transport for NSW is upgrading Banksia Station to make it easier for everyone to access public transport, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

The project includes:

- three new lifts to the station platforms
- improvements to the existing underpass
- new kiss and ride area and accessible parking space on Hattersley Street
- upgrades to CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage
- modifications to the existing station building on Platforms 2 and 3 to provide unisex ambulant toilets and a family accessible toilet
- regrading sections of the platforms
- additional canopy coverage along Platforms 2, 3 and 4.

Upcoming work and site set up

From **Monday 28 September**, site set up work will begin and continue in October.

Activities include:

- · site office set up
- installing temporary fencing on Platforms 2 and 3 and on Railway Street
- installing temporary stairs on both Railway and Hattersley streets
- set up of a temporary Station Master Office, including electrical and plumbing work, on Platforms 2 and 3
- relocating electrical services at the new lift areas
- removal of the Station Master Office in the underpass and the structure on Platforms 2 and 3 to allow construction of the new lift, subject to approval.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, crane, sucker truck, delivery truck and hand held power tools.
