Upcoming work

Work will continue in January and includes:

- Continued excavation for the new lift on Como Parade
- Saw cutting and demolition of the underpass slab for new drainage
- Installation of drainage and services
- Concrete pours for a new underpass slab
- Electrical installation work in the station precinct
- Commencement of toilet upgrade work.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, hammer drills, bobcats, hand held saws and electrical tools.



Changes to pedestrian access

The Como Parade access ramp is temporarily closed from 30 November for approximately 3 months.

This will allow the safe construction of the new lift on Como Parade. Access to and from Como Station will be available via the Railway Road entrance only.

The temporary closure is required for the safety of customers and our workers while excavation work is completed.

Blue markers show unavailable car parking spaces, green markers show bidirectional pedestrian access around the station.

Temporary changes to commuter car parking

Up to 38 parking spaces are temporarily closed in the commuter car park from 30 November to 28 February 2021. This includes 24 spaces in the nothern end of the Como Parade car park and 14 car parking spaces closer to the station entrance.

These temporary closures are essential to enable safe excavation and material removal for the new lift. Changes to the commuter car park are expected to occur for up to three months and parking will be reinstated gradually as construction progresses. Traffic control will be in place for the safety of vehicle and pedestrain, as required.

Temporary changes to the station toilets

In **late January 2021** work will begin to refurbish the existing toilets to provide a new male and female ambulant toilets and one family accessible toilet. This work is expected to take approximately three months to complete.

To enable this upgrade, one toilet will be closed at a time while work is carried out. During this time one toilet will be converted to a unisex toilet for all customers to use. Signage will be in place to direct customers to the unisex toilet.

Construction hours

To support the industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites to operate on weekends and public holidays. Standard construction hours are now **7am to 6pm every day, including Sundays public holidays.** These changes have been made to faciliate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.
