Como Station Upgrade

Project update

November 2020

Como Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure. The upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, carers/parents with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

Work will continue in November and includes:

- Concrete work for new lift pit, lift shaft and lobby area underneath the platform
- Concrete work for the Railway Road ramp
- Finishing work to the Railway Road ramp including handrails and balustrades.

Interesting finds at Como Station

A local resident highlighted to the construction team the original existing gate from the Gate Keeper's House. This house was purpose built for the employee responsible for managing the level crossing at the station, dating back to 1950. The project team is investigating opportunities to display this at the station!

Changes to pedestrian access

Railway Road entrance – opening late November

Late October saw the partial opening of the Railway Road station entrance/exit, with access to Como Station underpass re-instated via the stairs. During the month of November, work to upgrade the Railway Road station access ramp will be completed. The ramp is expected to reopen in late November.

Como Parade access ramp – temporarily closed for 2 months from Monday 30 November

The Como Parade access ramp will be closed from Monday 30 November for approximately 2 months (with partial opening over the festive break, from 19 December 2020 to 4 January 2021). This will allow the safe construction of the new lift on Como Parade. Access to and from Como Station will be available via the Railway Road entrance only. The temporary closure is required to ensure the safety of customers and our workers while we complete excavation work. The newly upgraded Railway Road ramp and stairs will be available to customers during this time.

Construction hours

To support the industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites to operate on weekends and public holidays. Standard construction hours are now **7am to 6pm every day, including Sundays public holidays**. These changes have been made to facilitate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.
