Canley Vale Station Upgrade

Project Update

August 2020



Project overview

Transport for NSW is upgrading Canley Vale Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

The project includes:

- two new lifts from the existing footbridge to the station platforms
- a new accessible parking space and kiss and ride on First Avenue
- one family accessible toilet and two ambulant toilets
- upgraded station entrance and widened footpath on Railway Parade

• upgrades to the station building and facilities to include new wayfinding signage and improved station lighting, security and communication systems.

Work is expected to be complete in mid- 2022.

Night work

Site investigation work will be carried out on the footpath in front of Canley Vale Station on Railway Parade from 6pm Monday 3 August to 7am Tuesday 4 August and from 6pm Tuesday 4 August to 7am Wednesday 5 August 2020.

This work will be carried out at night to maintain safety of our workers and community and is in line with our road occupancy licence for a required lane closure.

Traffic control will be in place to direct pedestrians and motorists where necessary and walking access around the work area will be maintained at all times.

All high noise activities associated with this work will be carried out between **6pm** to **10pm** on both nights.

Activities will include:

- concrete and pavement cutting, drilling test pits, and jack hammering
- · services investigation work including surveying
- restoring the footpath.

This work will involve a vacuum and tipper truck, plate compactor, demo saw, lighting tower, upright rammer and hand tools.

Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise including turning off vehicles when not in use, monitoring noise levels, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

For the safety of staff, rail customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified before out of hours work takes place.
