Project Update

Upcoming work in November

Work will begin from **Monday 2 November 2020** to start site set up and relocate the high voltage power lines at Canley Vale Station.

Activities will include:

- temporary connection of water and power to site offices within the rail corridor
- excavating and concrete work for new cable routes and high voltage power poles on First Avenue
- vegetation removal and tree pruning along First Avenue commuter car parking spaces (subject to approval)
- excavating and installing power poles along First Avenue and Railway Parade
- installing overhead wiring on First Avenue and Carcoola Street.

Equipment to be used includes vacuum trucks, mini loaders, trucks, excavators, stump grinder and chipper, lifter borer, jack hammer, concrete trucks and line pump, cranes and hand tools.

Temporary loss of commuter parking on First Avenue

Up to 50 commuter parking spaces along First Avenue will be temporarily closed from **4am Monday 9 November** until **10pm Sunday 15 November 2020** to safely and efficiently relocate the high voltage power lines at the station. The car park will be used to install new power poles, store materials and carry out tree pruning and vegetation removal (subject to approval).

Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists around the work area.

Alternative parking is available on surrounding streets as well as in the commuter car park on Fornasier Lane. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your patience while we complete this important work.

Weekend work in November 2020

Work will occur continuously from **6pm Friday 13 November to 10pm Sunday 15 November.** This is to allow the power supply work to take place within the rail corridor during scheduled Sydney Trains track work periods, when trains are not running.

There will be noise associated with this work. Where possible, measures to reduce noise will be used including turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, monitoring noise levels, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods.

Temporary footpath closure

From **7am Saturday 14 November** to **6pm Sunday 15 November 2020**, there will be a temporary footpath closure on the northern side of Carcoola Street (between First and Second Avenue) to allow installation of new overhead power cables. Residential access will be maintained. Pedestrians will be redirected to the other side of Carcoola Street.

Please allow extra travel time and follow the instructions of traffic control staff and signage while this work is carried out.

For the safety of staff, rail customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified before out of hours work takes place.
