Bexley North Station Upgrade

Project update July 2020

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Bexley North Station. The upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

Bexley North Station Upgrade will provide a station accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, carers/parents with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work in July

Construction on the Bexley North Station Upgrade commenced in May with site establishment activities.

Construction activities will continue in July and include:

- set up of temporary hoarding on the platform
- construction of an in-ground structure on the platform for the new and temporary access stairs
- removal of construction material from the platform
- relocation of platform services including CCTV and Opal Card readers
- construction of a temporary access pad from the railway corridor access gate off Kingsgrove Avenue for construction vehicles.

Weekend work: 4 and 5 July 2020

Work will be carried out continuously from 2am Saturday 4 July until 2am Monday 6 July 2020 during a scheduled track work weekend. For information about rail replacement buses during the scheduled track work, please visit transportnsw.info or phone 131 500.

Activities during the 4 and 5 July weekend work include:

- construction of concrete foundations on the platform next to the existing stairs
- set up of temporary hoarding along the railway corridor embankment wall (next to the commuter car park)
- removal of eight trees near the commuter car park (at the location of the new car park access ramp)
- installation of a concrete supply line along Bexley Road footpath and platform stairs to enable direct supply of concrete to the lift construction area from concrete delivery trucks in the car park.

Equipment to be used includes piling rigs, excavators, delivery trucks, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, elevated work platforms, power and hand tools.

The construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this important work.

Construction hours

Under new rules introduced by the NSW Government to support the construction industry during the COVID-19 situation, some construction sites can now operate on weekends and public holidays.

Under the new Order, standard construction hours are now 7am to 6pm every day, including public holidays.

The Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order 2020 will continue for up to six months and all changes to the Order will be communicated accordingly.

It enables workers to abide by social distancing rules while keeping construction projects progressing by allowing building work to be spread across more days of the week.

Bexley North Station Upgrade will utilise these additional hours to facilitate social distancing on site and support the health and wellbeing of all workers.

The project remains committed to minimising the impacts on the community and will avoid noisy work where possible during the weekend construction hours. All reasonable measures to reduce noise impacts will continue to be implemented, including using the quietest equipment possible, placing machinery and vehicles as far away from properties as possible, conducting high noise generating activities during weekdays where possible, and implementing respite periods as required.

High impact noise generating activities are still subject to restrictions specified in the project's planning approval conditions.

The community will continue to be notified in advance of any work that will take place outside the new standard construction hours.

This measure has been put in place to support the industry and is in line with current medical advice, to keep our workers and the community safe and healthy.


Temporary changes: commuter car park

From **Monday 29 June until Friday 10 July 2020**, a portion of the Kingsgrove Avenue commuter car park will be closed to prepare for the weekend work occurring from 4 to 5 July.

Remaining spaces in the car park are available to use during this time.

Localised traffic control and signs will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with the temporary changes. See the map below for more information.
