

Transport Access Program Bellambi Station Upgrade Have your say

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Bellambi Station

Planning is under way to improve accessibility at Bellambi Station. This will make it easier for everyone to use the station, especially those with additional mobility requirements, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

We would like to hear from you about access to Bellambi Station and our proposed upgrades. Feedback is open until **Sunday 31 October.**

What are we proposing?

We have assessed Bellambi Station against the *Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport (DSAPT)* and the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (DDA)*, the legislation which sets the standards for accessibility in Australia. To meet these standards and improve safety and accessibility at the station, our proposed upgrades will include:

- updating the existing level crossing pedestrian zone
- · upgrading the existing ramp
- creating two new accessible parking spaces
- · creating a formal kiss and ride zone
- installing a new bike shelter
- constructing a new station building further along the platform which will include accessible amenities
- demolishing the old platform building to achieve compliant platform widths and access paths
- upgrading existing lighting to increase security.

You may have noticed upgrades under way at Unanderra and Towradgi stations. Along with Bellambi and Dapto stations, they are part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.
