Project update

Upcoming work

Construction of Bexley North Station Upgrade is continuing, with work to construct the new lift and stairs to the platforms and a new ramp within the Commuter Car Park currently underway. Construction activities will continue throughout May, and include:

- excavation and services installation on the platform, in the Commuter Car Park, and within the rail corridor
- installation of handrails to the new platform stairs
- refurbishment of the platform building including the conversion of the existing female toilet into a unisex ambulant toilet
- pre-fabrication of the new concourse within the Commuter Car Park
- pre-assembly of the new lift shaft and concourse canopy within the Commuter Car Park
- delivery of materials and equipment to the Commuter Car Park and rail corridor
- removal of construction materials from underneath the temporary stairs.

Equipment to be used includes delivery trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, excavators, rollers, small mobile cranes, power and hand tools.

Night work from 3 to 7 May 2021

Work to install underground services, and move materials to and from the platform, will be carried out from **6pm to 6am each night** from **Monday 3 May until Friday 7 May 2021.** This work is carried out at night to maintain the safety of our workers and coincides with a Sydney Trains scheduled trackwork period when **train services do not operate between 8:50pm and 4am**.

Equipment to be used includes delivery trucks, lighting towers, power and hand tools.

The night work will be primarily located inside the rail corridor, and there may be some noise associated with this work. Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce impacts, such as turning off vehicles when not in use, using non-tonal reversing beepers, and monitoring noise levels.

Changes to station toilets

To enable refurbishment of the station toilets, the existing female toilet in the station building will be temporarily closed until late 2021. The former male toilet in the station building has been refurbished and will be operating as a unisex toilet during this time. Signage has been installed to help customers with these temporary changes. When complete, the station will feature a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet.

Kingsgrove Avenue parking and access changes

To create a safe working area for construction of the access ramp and car park upgrades, there will be ongoing temporary parking and access changes including:

- temporary closure of the Kingsgrove Avenue Commuter Car Park **until late 2021**. Parking will remain available for commuters on Kingsgrove Avenue, west of the Commuter Car Park
- temporary closure of up to 18 car parking spaces along the rail corridor boundary fence
- temporary lane width reduction.

Pedestrians are to continue to access the station via Kingsgrove Avenue and Bexley Road footpath.

Motorists, please allow extra travel time and follow the direction of signage including reduced speed limits while the temporary changes are in place on Kingsgrove Avenue (westbound).

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are from 7am to 6pm every day, including public holidays.

We understand extending construction hours to include weekends and public holidays may cause disruption, with all efforts made to minimise impacts where possible and ensure strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.
