Project Update

Completed work in Teresa Street, Birrong

Transport for NSW is upgrading Birrong Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

Work will continue in April and includes:

- electrical work
- upgrading the station building and toilets
- installing the new lift
- structural steel and finishing work.

Equipment to be used includes hand tools, delivery vehicles, traffic controls, and temporary fencing.

We thank you for your patience during this important work.

Night work in March/April

For the safety of our pedestrians, commuters and motorists, work will take place at night over three nights from **Monday 29 March to Thursday 1 April** between **10:00pm and 4:00am**, weather permitting. This night work will occur during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period, when trains are not running.

This work will involve

- minor steel work on the canopies
- installing cladding on the canopies and Boarding Assistance Zone shelters
- laying brickwork on Avalon Street bridge.

Equipment to be used includes generator and hand tools.

This work is not expected to be noisy. Wherever possible measures to reduce noise will be implemented including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers. There may be some temporary partial closures to the pedestrian footpath over Avalon Street bridge during this work.

Buses will replace trains during this night work and bus stop locations will be located on Auburn Road, near the intersection of Rodd Street. Please visit www.transportnsw.info or call 131 500 for up to date information regarding service updates and replacement buses during this time.

Traffic and parking impacts in April

Short term temporary traffic controls may be in place during April to allow for truck deliveries. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and motorists during the temporary changes. Please follow the directions of traffic controllers and signage, and allow extra travel time.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.
