


Transport Access Program

Canley Vale Station Upgrade

Community notification

July/August 2021

Transport for NSW is improving accessibility at Canley Vale Station. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

Work will continue in July and August and includes:

- installation and testing of lifts 1 and 2
- installation of new fencing
- removal of site sheds
- installation of tactiles on Platforms 1 and 2
- general civil and electrical work
- finishing work on lifts 1 and 2

Equipment to be used includes trucks, elevated work platforms, drill rigs, scaffolding, crane, and hand tools.

Bus stop to reopen

From **12 July 2021**, the bus stop next to Canley Vale Station on Railway Parade will reopen for customers. The temporary bus stop on Canley Vale Road and the temporary night bus stop on Railway Parade will close from this date. Please see map overleaf.

This will impact bus route 817 (Fairfield to Cabramatta) services, school bus routes 9548 (Our Lady of the Rosary PS to Cabramatta via Wakeley) and 9557 (Mary MacKillop College to Cabramatta), N50 Night Services (Town Hall Station to Liverpool Station), and 29T2 and 80T2 Replacement Train Services.

Weekend work in August 2021

From **6pm on Friday 6 August** to **5am on Monday 9 August 2021**, work will take place continuously during a Sydney Trains trackwork weekend, when trains are not running.

Work will take place in the rail corridor, at the station, and on First Avenue, and includes:

- removal of site compound
- removal of hoarding around the lift shafts
- painting and finishing work of lift shafts and canopies on Platforms 1 and 2
- installation of tactiles on Platforms 1 and 2

Equipment to be used includes trucks, cranes, elevated work platform, excavators, generators, drill rigs, rattle guns, lighting towers and hand tools. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists around the work area when required.

The work activities will be noisy at times. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact by turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise levels, using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers. Lighting towers will be solar powered to further reduce noise.

Access changes during weekend work

To carry out this work safely, the following temporary access changes will be in place throughout the weekend. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.

Road closures and temporary parking changes

From 6pm on Friday 6 August to 8pm on Sunday 8 August, the following changes will be in place:

- The kiss and ride zone and accessible parking space on First Avenue will be temporarily closed.
- One lane of traffic on First Avenue towards Carcoola Street may be closed intermittently to allow for delivery trucks to access the site compound.

Pedestrian access changes

The footpath on the station side of First Avenue will be blocked and pedestrians will need to use the footpaths on the opposite side of the street. Pedestrian detour will also be in place on Railway Parade. Please see map overleaf for details. Traffic controllers and directional signage will be in place to assist pedestrians. **The pedestrian footbridge will remain open for customers.**
