

# **Transport Access Program**

Canley Vale Station Upgrade

## **Community Notification**

October/November 2021

Transport for NSW is upgrading Canley Vale Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents or carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

# **Upcoming work**

Work continuing in October and November includes:

- general civil and electrical work
- removing site sheds and hoarding

To carry out this work we'll uses trucks, elevated work platforms, drill rigs, scaffolding, a crane and hand tools.

## Weekend work in October 2021

From **6pm on Friday 22 October** to **5am on Monday 25 October 2021**, work will take place continuously during a Sydney Trains trackwork weekend, when trains are not running.

Work will take place in the rail corridor, at the station, and on Railway Parade and First Avenue, and includes:

- painting and finishing work of lift shafts and canopies on Platforms 1 and 2
- removing the site compound
- removing hoarding around the lift shafts

To carry out this work we'll use trucks, cranes, elevated work platform, generators, lighting towers and hand tools. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists around the work area when required.

Some of the work will be noisy. Every effort will be made to minimise the noise by turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise levels, using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers and solar powered lighting towers.

# Access changes during weekend work

To carry out this work safely, temporary access changes will be in place throughout the weekend. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.

### Road closures and temporary parking changes

From 6pm on Friday 22 October to 8pm on Sunday 24 October, the following changes will be in place:

- The kiss and ride zone and accessible parking space on First Avenue will be temporarily closed.
- One lane of traffic on First Avenue towards Carcoola Street may be closed intermittently to allow for delivery trucks to access the site compound.

#### Pedestrian access changes

The footpath on the station side of First Avenue will be blocked and pedestrians will need to use the footpaths on the opposite side of the street. Pedestrian detour will also be in place on Railway Parade. Please see map below for details. Traffic controllers and directional signage will be in place to assist pedestrians. The pedestrian footbridge will remain open for customers.
