# Canley Vale Station Upgrade

# **Project Update**

May/June 2021

Transport for NSW is improving accessibility at Canley Vale Station. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

# Weekend work in May 2021

From **6pm on Friday 28 May** to **5am on Monday 31 May**, work will take place continuously during a Sydney Trains trackwork weekend, when trains are not running.

Work will take place in the rail corridor, at the station, and on First Avenue and Railway Parade and includes:

- installing new tactile indicators from the station platforms
- installing new lift landing canopies on the station platforms
- installing glazing and cladding on the lift structures
- installing balustrades and handrails on the station platforms
- regrading work on Platform 2
- landscaping work on First Avenue
- electrical and building work in the station building and on the platforms
- removal of site sheds.

Equipment to be used includes trucks, cranes, elevated work platform, grinder, vacuum trucks, excavators, jack hammer, dump trucks, concrete vehicles, line pump, piling rig, lighting towers and hand tools.

Traffic control, security and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists around the work area when required. The work activities will be noisy at times. We apologise for the inconvenience and will minimise the impact by turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise levels, using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers. Lighting towers will be solar powered to further reduce noise.

# Access changes during weekend work

To carry out this work safely, temporary pedestrian and vehicle access changes will be in place. Traffic controllers, security and signage will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.

## Road closures and parking changes

From 9pm on Thursday 27 May to 8pm on Sunday 30 May, the following changes will be in place:

 First Avenue will be closed, north of Carcoola Street, including the commuter car park. Access will be maintained for residents and visitors to ACDMA Aged Hostel.

From 10pm on Friday 28 May to 8pm on Sunday 30 May, the following changes will be in place:

- A single lane closure will be in place on Railway Parade, next to the station.
- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.



# Pedestrian access changes

• The footpath on the station side of First Avenue will be blocked and pedestrians will need to use the footpaths on the opposite side of the street. Traffic controllers and directional signage will be in place to assist pedestrians. The pedestrian footbridge will remain open for customers.

# Bus stop closures and diversions

Due to work being undertaken at the station, customers can access replacement bus services from the temporary bus stop located on Canley Vale Road during the day and on Railway Parade at night. Please see below map for temporary bus stop locations.

# Night work in June

From **8pm to 8am on Wednesday 9, Thursday 10, Wednesday 16, and Thursday 17 June**, work will take place to complete footpath upgrades on Railway Parade.

Equipment to be used includes trucks, concrete vehicles, line pump, jackhammers, generators, lighting towers and hand tools.

Traffic control, security and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists around the work area when required. The work activities will be noisy at times. We apologise for the inconvenience and will minimise the impact by turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise levels, using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers. Lighting towers will be solar powered to further reduce noise.



## Other activities in June

Work activities in June include:

- landscaping and tree planting
- installing road and platform furniture
- installing new handrails and balustrades
- continuing electrical and mechanical work
- installing glazing and cladding on the lift structures

Equipment to be used includes trucks, elevated work platform, grinder, vacuum trucks, excavators, jack hammer, concrete vehicles, line pump, piling rig and hand tools.

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
