

Transport Access Program Canley Vale



Canley Vale Station Upgrade is now complete and the community is able to use the station's new and improved accessibility features.

Customers can use the two new lifts to access the platforms and station amenities, including a new family accessible toilet, a male ambulant toilet and a female ambulant toilet.

CCTV, wayfinding signage and lighting have been improved to increase safety and security around the station precinct.

A new accessible parking space and a kiss and ride area are available on First Avenue. The footpath has been widened on Railway Parade to allow easier access to the station.
