# **Transport Access Program Bellambi Station Upgrade**

Community notification October 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Bellambi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

### Completed work

Work continued on the car park and lighting upgrades in September. The dedicated accessible parking spaces were temporarily relocated to allow for work at the level crossing end of the car park.

The new station building foundation work was completed and the electrical and communications conduits were installed.

#### **Upcoming work**

In October, the next stage of the car park upgrade, including the new kiss and ride zone, will start, and a temporary canopy will be installed on the southern side of the existing station building to allow for the removal of the northern canopy. The canopy will be removed during the next scheduled rail shutdown weekend.

## Commuter car park

To allow for the safe delivery of equipment and materials, and to accommodate upcoming work at the northern end of the car park, the accessible parking has been relocated and some parking spaces will be unavailable.

The car park will be completely closed twice in October. During this time there will be limited parking on Francis Street. The community and residents directly affected will be notified when the dates are confirmed.
