

Transport Access Program

Dapto Station Upgrade

Community notification September 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Dapto Station. This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.



Preparations for the foundations of the platform extension have started.

Completed work

In July the site compound was set up, complete with site sheds, fencing, barriers, some equipment and materials. The compound is located behind Platform 1, with construction vehicles entering via Bong Bong Road and is expected to remain in place until early 2023.

Foundation work started behind Platform 1 to support the platform widening. Some excavation works also began at the front of the station for a new station services pit.

Upcoming work

In September we will start accessibility modifications to the waiting room and the ticket window area. During this time, entry to these areas will be from Platform 2. Signage will direct customers to the alternate entrance.

Works to the structure for the widening of Platform 1 will continue throughout early September. Construction vehicles will enter via Bong Bong Road and traffic control will be in place for safety and to minimise traffic disruptions.

Working hours

Work will occur during construction hours between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **Saturday 8am to 1pm**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Other work in the area

The More Trains, More Services program is upgrading the rail network to support the introduction of the Mariyung fleet.

As part of the program, Transport for NSW are extending platforms, upgrading infrastructure, and re-building the maintenance depot at Dapto Station.
