# Transport Access Program Denistone Station Upgrade

Transport for NSW | October 2022

The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Denistone Station customers, with an upgraded station accessible to all, including those with a disability or limited mobility, parents and carers with prams and customers with luggage.

### During October we will:

- Continue repair works on the concourse and station buildings, including removal of lead paint and steel.
- Continue construction of lift shafts above platform level and the installation of scaffolds around both lifts.
- Install new utilities outlets for station power and communication supply along Gordon Crescent side entrance, platforms and garden beds.
- Upgrade stormwater pipes to connect to new canopies on the lift shaft and platforms.
- Construct new toilet facilities and continue works on the waiting room on Platforms 3 and 4.

We will also construct a concrete slab for the new electricity transformer, investigate and relocate some services and resurface the platforms.

#### Our work schedule

Our work hours are between **7am** and **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

We understand that our work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to lessen the disturbance, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Temporary changes may be in place during our work hours to safely detour people around the work zone. Thank you for your continued patience and for using caution around the areas of work.

# Weekend and night works

For the safety of our workers, pedestrians and motorists, work will take place from **2am Saturday 29 October** to **2am Monday 31 October 2022**, weather permitting. Some of these works will take place in the rail corridor and needs to be carried out during a scheduled Sydney Trains track work period when trains are not running.

If this October weekend work proceeds, some residents will be contacted directly about respite offers due to noise levels. The purpose of these respite offers is to provide directly affected households with a short break from the noise from construction activities.

# How will the work affect you?

From Wednesday 26 October to Monday 31 October, the Gordon Crescent Car Park will be closed to all customers.

There will be the temporary loss of some on-street parking on East Parade, West Parade and Ryedale Road near railway access gates during this period to allow for the delivery of work vehicles and construction materials.

Please allow extra travel time and follow the instructions of traffic control staff and signage while this work is carried out. Please see the map below outlining these works and detours.
