Denistone Station Upgrade

Transport for NSW | February 2022

The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Denistone customers with an upgraded station accessible to all including those with a disability, limited mobility, parents and carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Transport for NSW received 39 submissions during the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors between Friday 3 December and Friday 17 December 2021.

All submissions received were considered as part of the planning process and have been addressed in the Determination Report, which can be found on the project website **transport.nsw.gov.au/Denistone**

We listened - and this is what we learnt

We listened to your feedback and welcome the community support for improving accessibility at Denistone Station.

Other feedback we received included:

- the importance of the existing art deco station design
- requests for additional weather protection
- more parking and improved visibility around the Gordon Crescent overbridge.

To improve the community's experience in and around the station we will:

- Increase station wet weather protection by installing canopies at the boarding assistance zones and lift lobbies
- install screening at the station's front entrance in consideration of art deco aesthetics
- maintain active transport links to the station, including cycleway connections
- continue to consult with a heritage architect as we develop our detailed designs.

Key features of the upgrade:

- two new lifts connecting the station concourse to platforms
- new boarding assistance zone canopies and new benches on both platforms
- upgraded accessible paths from the new lifts to the boarding assistance zones and station amenities
- upgraded handrails for existing stairs to platforms
- reinstated heritage awning at the station entrance new kiss and ride bay on Gordon Crescent
- new family accessible toilet and new unisex ambulant toilet within the existing station building on Platform 1 and 2
- one new accessible parking space in the commuter car park on Gordon Crescent
- upgraded footpath and ramp access between the station entrance and the car park on Gordon Crescent
- improved CCTV, lighting and wayfinding.

Upcoming work

Detailed design is now underway.

We are preparing to establish the site work compound in the Kinson Crescent carpark from **Monday 7 March 2022.**

Our work activities will include:

- surveying of land
- site establishment work
- installing the site office compound and timber hoarding
- inspection, investigating and relocating services.

This work will occur during standard construction hours between **7am** and **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**. We will contact you to advise of any work required outside these hours.

We will continue to keep the community informed throughout the construction period.

Weekend work

We will also be working at Denistone Station and within the rail corridor continuously from 2am Saturday 12 March to 10pm Sunday 13 March to complete work that can only be done during scheduled rail shutdown periods.

In addition to the upcoming work list, the weekend work includes:

- piling work on station platforms
- concrete work from West Parade and Gordon Crescent to the station platforms
- excavation and concreting the lift pits on the station platforms
- delivery and disposal of materials.

The equipment used during the work will include piling rigs, excavators, dump trucks, bogie trucks, concrete line pump, rattle guns and hand tools.

How will the work affect you?

During the weekend work, Denistone Station and the Gordon Crescent carpark will be closed to the public. Buses will replace trains during this time. Please visit www.transportnsw.info or call 131 500 for up-to-date information regarding service updates and replacement buses during this time.

From **Monday 7 March**, the Kinson Crescent car park will be closed to create a temporary site compound for the duration of the project.

We will make parking spaces available as early as possible. Please plan your journey ahead of time as it may take longer than usual to find a parking space.

We understand that this work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to lessen the disturbance including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
