
The Transport Access Program is making Denistone Station better for all.

We're almost finished with the upgrade, which will make the station more accessible to passengers with disabilities, limited mobility, prams, luggage and bicycles.

Work completed

Recently we have:

- resurfaced the platforms and concourse.
- improved the station's power supply to power the new lifts.
- completed the internal fit out of the two new lifts.
- installed new tactile ground surface indicators to enhance navigation and safety for visually impaired passengers.
- installed hearing loops to provide clearer audio for passengers with hearing impairments.

What work are we doing?

In September 2023, our **work hours** will be **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **7am to 1pm on Saturday**.

We will:

- install the perforated screens and complete balustrade and handrail adjustments along the concourse.
- complete restoration of the station's heritage awnings.
- finish the new unisex ambulant bathroom on platform two.
- undertake final testing of the new lifts connecting concourse and platform levels.
- install wayfinding signage.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles around the station.
- traffic controllers and signage.
- noise from machinery and equipment during standard work hours.

Managing our work

We aim to manage our work to avoid effects to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing for safety and security.
- reducing noise as much as possible.
