

Transport Access Program Bellambi Station Upgrade

Community notification February 2023

Transport for NSW is upgrading accessibility at Bellambi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program to provide a better experience for public transport customers.

Completed work

In January the steel structure for the new station building was installed on the platform, and the roofing was prepared for the next stages of fitting out and cladding.

Service containment work continued along the rail corridor fence next to the car park, and the bike shelter and bicycle parking area were installed. Work on the kiss and ride zone also continued.

Upcoming work

Work on the new station building will continue in February, with outside walls lined, internal fit-out and electrical and plumbing services to begin.

Service containment work will also continue along the rail corridor fence next to the car park.

Commuter car park

New designated accessible parking spaces in the commuter car park will be open to the public mid-February. Some parking spaces at the southern end of the car park will continue to be temporarily unavailable to allow the safe delivery of materials and work to continue.

Working hours

We will be working standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.
